

## **SUGGESTED PROTOCOL FOR HOSTING THE WTC STEEL DISPLAY**

**Please keep in mind we wish to give this display the honor and dignity it deserves**

It will be the receiving departments responsibility to arrange for pick up of the display from its current location.

Receiving department will transport the piece of steel in a fire department apparatus with uniformed personnel. (Uniform may be what the department deems it's as it's dress uniform code)

(Steel is approximately 30" in length and 110lbs)

Receiving department will also need a pickup truck or van for the Flag of Heroes, the FDNY flags and the custom stand.

(Flag of Heroes measures 66 ¼" x 49 ¾". It is framed with a glass front)

Also accompanying the display is a journal for visitors to sign their name. It is a dated journal so on the dates your department hosts the display write your department name, address and Chief's name at the top of the page.

Each hosting department is asked to add their department patch to the display as well

(The journal, and department patches will be presented to the Alabama Fire College along with the WTC Steel on Saturday June 2 and will become a permanent part of the display)

We are suggesting that you place the display in a public place, if possible, for all your community to be able to visit. Library, church, civic center, etc. The desire is for visitors to be able to touch the steel and reflect upon that dreadful day. Also take to opportunity to publicize it's presence. It's a great opportunity for PR for your department as well as the display.

While on public display we ask that you post at least one uniformed member to stand guard during the hours of visitation. **The steel must**

**be secured when not on display. Not subject to theft, vandalism, etc.**

We will provide all the information you need for the display.
